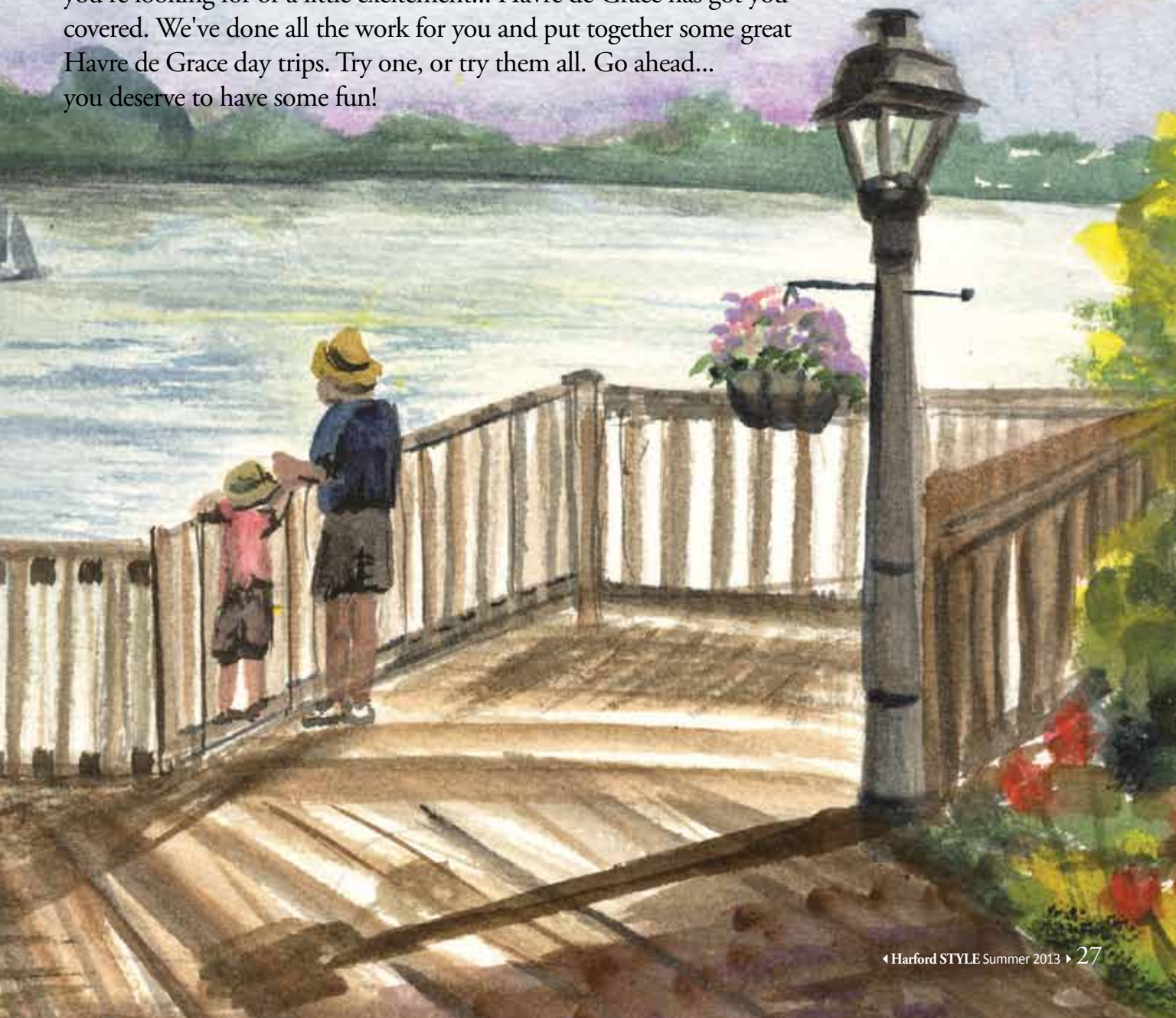




# Havre de Grace

Enjoy live music at Laurrapin

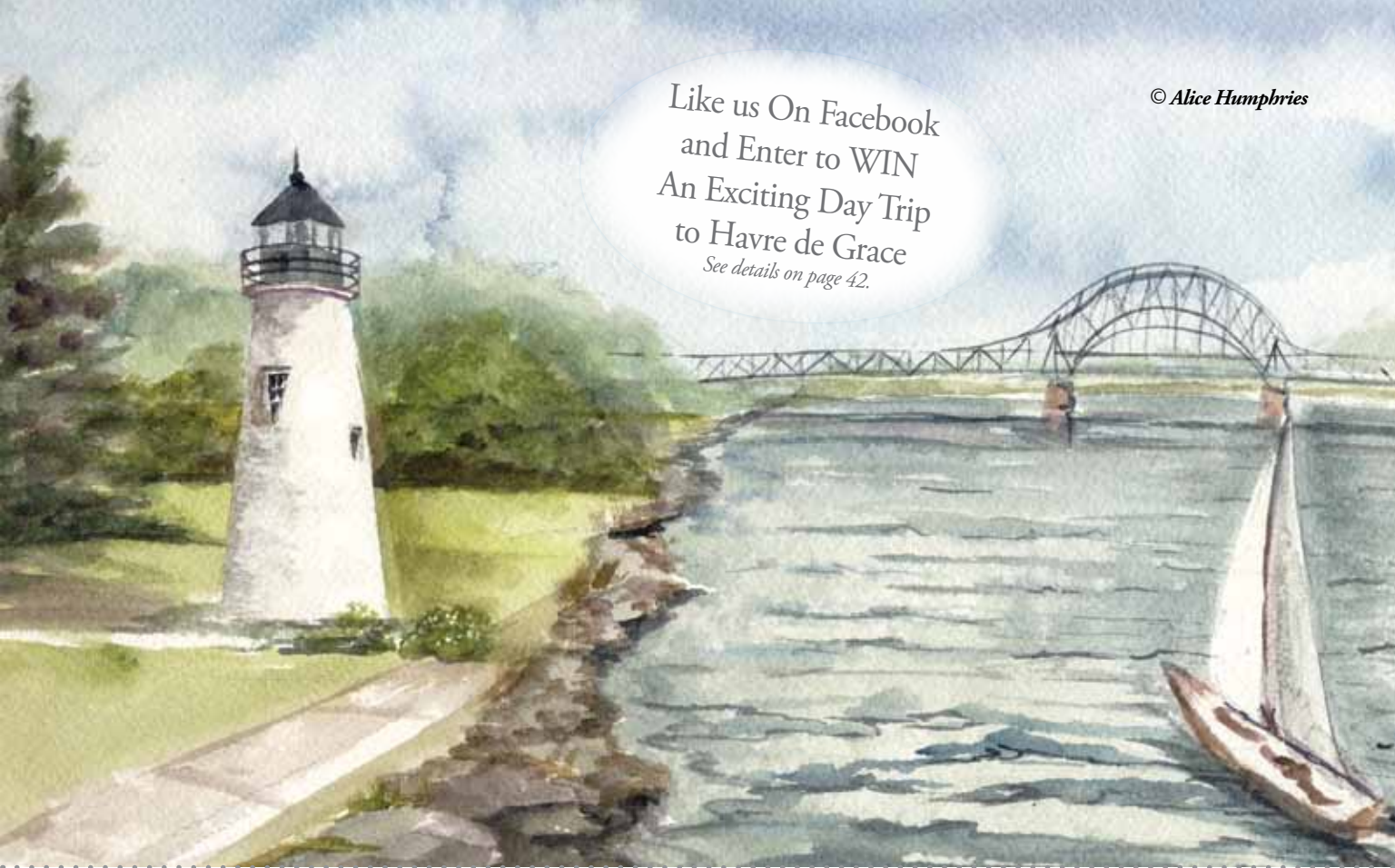
### Option 2
